Discipline and Sunday groups

We want our groups to be places where children and young people enjoy being and are engaged in meeting and knowing God - so it's so frustrating when poor behaviour stops that happening! This video gives on overview of what discipline is (and isn't) and considers the many factors that can lead to poor behaviour. We think about how to structure our sessions to minimise opportunities for poor behaviour and then offer a three tier system for discipline - whatever is going on.

- What discipline is discipline is about learning, not punishment, we should model how we discipline on how God relates to us, and the many reasons kids misbehave
- **Set up for success** prioritise relationships, set up your room to minimise distractions and maximise the team's influence, and plan thinking about how to minimise opportunities for poor behaviour.
- **The three levels of discipline** stopping poor behaviour as it starts, using choices, and dealing with tricky situations.

Discussion questions

Below are some suggestions to help you discuss the ideas with your team – please use or discard them – you know your team best!

- Do you have any comments or questions about the video? What stood out to you the most?
- Is the idea of discipline as actually being about providing opportunities for a child or young person to learn one you find helpful? Why or why not?
- Thinking about the kids you work with, do you recognise different reasons for their poor behaviour?
- What are our groups like? Do we experience behaviour problems? Can we identify why?
- How do you feel about the 'three levels' of discipline? Can you see that working in our context?
- What is our next step?
